

# ***Spring Clean-Up Information***

***May 13, 2017***

## **For residents in the special assessment district:**

- All trash must be bagged, boxed or bundled.
- **DO NOT** put items at the curb until the day before the pick-up is scheduled.
- Curb-side pick-up will start at 6:00 AM.
- Senior citizens are encouraged to call the Township Hall at 495-5381 (extension 102), in advance, to arrange for assistance.
- **DO NOT** put leaves or branches at the curb. State law will not allow refuse haulers to accept yard waste.
- All appliances must be tagged as free of “Freon” (refrigerant) by the company that removes the refrigerant in order to be picked up.
- Hazardous materials, paint, fluorescent light bulbs, tires, and computer monitors will not be picked up. Contact Northern Transitions, Inc. at 906-635-5681 to arrange to drop them off.

## **For residents outside the special assessment district:**

- Each residence may pick up a “Dump Pass” at the township hall. Passes will be good from May 5<sup>th</sup> through May 19<sup>th</sup>.
- Each residence is allowed 2 cubic yards of material. This is equal to one full-size pick-up bed loaded to the top rail. You will be expected to pay for anything in excess of 2 cubic yards.
- Refuse should be taken to Smith Sanitation/Blue Waters Recycling Transfer Station at 3239 W. M28, Brimley.
- The transfer station will be open from 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM Monday-Friday and 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM on Saturdays (May 6<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup>).
