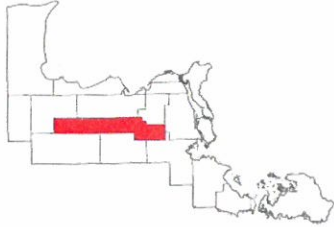


Kinross Charter Township, Chippewa County

Description: Located 20 miles south of Sault Ste. Marie, Kinross Charter Township is the second largest jurisdiction in the County. The former Kincheloe Air Force Base was converted to an industrial park and five state prison facilities in the 1970's. Today three state prisons are currently operating, which house approximately 42% of the population. The Chippewa County International Airport and Industrial Park are located on part of the old Base. The population center of Kinross is located in the eastern one-third of the Township where the former Air Force Base housing is now known as Woodside Housing. The Township maintains a Public Works Department, Police, Fire and Ambulance Service.
